Defence Common Access Card (DCAC) Escorting Responsibilities

Good Afternoon Team,

As a requirement for our Defence Industry Security Program (DISP) membership, any Cleared Defence Common Access Card (DCAC) holder whilst on a Defence Establishment, must follow the escorting responsibilities outlined within the Defence Security Principles Framework (DSPF) 02-Control-74.1-Physical-Access-Control, paragraphs 70 – 78.

All visitors must be signed in and escorted by a cleared DCAC holder at all times.

A Baseline cleared DCAC holder may escort up to 8 personnel at any one time, in zones up to Security Zone 3.

A Negative Vetting 1 (NV1) cleared DCAC holder may escort up to 4 personnel at any one time, in zones up to Security Zone 4.

All personnel must remain in line of sight of the escorting party at all times.

When an incident occurs please ensure it is reported immediately to BGIS Defence Security.
